\$300,000 to be awarded for innovative pediatric device projects!

The Midwest Pediatric Device Consortium (MPDC), The Alliance for Pediatric Device Innovation (APDI), The Consortium for Technology and Innovation in Pediatrics (CTIP), The Southwest Pediatric Device Consortium (SWPDC), & The UCSF-Stanford Pediatric Device Consortium are proud to announce our Fall 2026 Pediatric Device Pitch Competition. Abstract applications for **Pediatric Device Innovation Grants** will be accepted starting July 20 through August 14, 2026.

PDC Innovation Grants help drive promising pediatric device ideas towards market availability for patient benefit. Academic, business, and startup innovators based in the United States are invited to apply.

Thanks to funding from the U.S. Food & Drug Administration through the Pediatric Device Consortia Grants Program, a total of **\$300,000** in seed grants will be awarded.
